HIGHLIGHTS OF THE FEB. 20 GENERAL BOARD MEETING AT CHRISTIAN ACRES

DEEP DOWN DECISIONS ABOUT THE POOL

***REGISTERED LIFE GUARD REQUIRED

In order for C/A to be covered by insurance on the pool, a registered lifeguard must be present when anyone swims. C/A has hired Jody Frazier for the camp season in this regard. Churches who schedule the pool must bring a REGISTERED lifeguard or let us know when the reservation is made that Jody's services are needed. On weekends and when camp is not in session, the church must pay Jody \$4.00 an hour or \$8.00 for the two hour usage.

***FEE OF .50 TO BE CHARGED

Electricity alone last year ran over \$100 per month, not counting the cost of the chemicals. In an attempt to try to BREAK EVEN the C/A General Board has placed a .50 fee per person for the two hour swim.

***TIMES THE POOL WILL BE OPEN DURING CAMP

The hours from 10 - 12 in the morning and from 5 - 7 in the evening DURING CAMP WEEKS have been established as times individuals may come on campus and swim without reservation. Again, they will have to pay the .50 charge but not the lifeguard since he is being paid by the camp during the week.

***SCHEDULING THE USE OF THE POOL

Weekends from 10 a.m. til 9 p.m., any church group may schedule the pool during weeks of camp. When camp is not in session the pool may be scheduled during weekdays also. Please call the office at 589-6296 to book your reservation. In the event that you cannot reach me at this number, then dial 326-3097. The group must pay the lifeguard if they do not bring their own REGISTERED lifeguard plus .50 per person.

GROUND AND FACILITIES USE!

Only churches and church groups associated with Christian Acres will be allowed to use the pool, ballfield, and other facilities. The membership card does allow members to bring two guests, but no more. (See article on membership)
