136 MATTRESSES PAID FOR**

We have some good news - and some - better news! The dorm remodeling program has money on hand to purchase 136 mattresses - with commitments for several more bringing our total to near 144! Any additional monies received over the 150 mattress total will be used to do other improvements in the dorms for our campers! We received \$3448 alone just this past month!

Around the first of March we tried to recontact the mattress company in Roanoke that gave us the quote last Oct. of \$55 each. Apparently they have gone out of business, so we have contacted another company in N.H. where we can obtain a better price and be able to purchase the plywood also with the \$55 each of you has sent in. That's the "better news!"
