## JIM'S SEMI-RETIREMENT PACKAGE WORKED OUT

On March 12th, the Executive Committee met with Jim to work out details of his semi-retirement which begins this April 1st. Because of social security regulations, Jim is allowed to make only \$620 a month April through December. In order for us to keep our promise to him that we would pay him \$7500 for the last three quarters of this year, we had to pay him \$1921 before April 1st. We then will pay the legal amount of \$620 per month for the remainder of this year. January through March of 1993 we can pay Jim his \$833 scheduled salary.

The Executive Committee, on behalf of all the area churches, wants to thank Jim for his many years of service to the camp full-time and look forward to his continued part-time service in the future.
