PAVING PROJECT NOW ON 51 YD. LINE!


As of March 22, we have had 106 individuals or churches given 513½ yards of asphalt or \$5,135 toward our goal of \$10,000. By the time you receive this Chronicle, we will have only 6 weeks to collect the second half- the other 486½ yards needed to reach the "touchdown" of the pavement in mid-May. We have a new low bid of just over \$23,000 to have the paving done and will release this bid soon to have the work accomplished between the first and middle of May. WE NEED YOUR HELP! We've not received a single yard from some of our supporting churches - so please push this project for us because we won't be at your congregation with the video program until after the work is done.
