The 12th Annual Bluefield Ladies Retreat will take place on the C/A campus on August 12-13 beginning with Registration at 4:30-5:45. The fee for the entire clinic is only \$5 including all meals.

Highlighting this year's retreat is Patsy Wilson who will be speaking on the theme "Love In Deed!" With her husband Dr. Robert Wilson, she teamteaches marriage enrichment and family life retreats and seminars.

Besides the main sessions conducted by Mrs. Wilson, a host of workshops and panels will be held. Anita Yuhasz will conduct a workshop on "Bible Study and Prayer Group in Your Own Home", and Patsy Wilson will hold a workshop on "Holding the Family Together Through Love." A panel on Ways to Evangelize will also be presented at the retreat. Dolly Shrader will talk on Evangelism through Visitation; Joanna Mathenà - Evangelizing Through Camp; Shirley Mutter - Evangelizing Through Singles.

A pre-prayer meeting for the clinic will be held on August 4 at the Mountainview Church of Christ at 7:30. All ladies are urged to attend this important gathering.

WALK IN COOLER COMPRESSOR COSTS \$803.00!

During the Jr. High Week of Camp when we were feeding approximately 171 people three meals a day, our walk in cooler motor blew up. We had nursed the entire motor and compressor along for five years until the propellor shaft split apart and burned the entire motor up. A new motor would have cost \$250 alone if we could have found one to fit. It was decided that although we probably didn't have the funds to buy a new unit, that we would go in debt and purchase a brand new unit for \$803. The food in the cooler was spoiled. We moved the rest into our large refrigerator and the next day it went bad too. All in all we lost several hundred dollars worth of milk, meat, and other foods.

We appeal to our supporting congregations to consider our special need and prayerfully consider giving a one-time gift of \$100 to help us pay this debt. If only 8 congregations would respond, we could have this bill paid off!
