The last weekend in August, the 24th, 25th, and the 26th, C/A will host its 7th ANNUAL FAMILY CAMP AND REVIVAL SERVICES. Our special guest speaker this year is George Faull, a newcomer to our area. As president of Summit Theological Seminary in Indiana, George has traveled a large area, having been invited to speak upon the theme he will be developing here, "Divorce and Remarriage." Once you hear George the first time - you will want to hear him again and again. Set aside this weekend now and plan to either camp at or commute to C/A. We have the entire schedule listed below.

Sunday night, as in the past 6 years, we will have the ALL AREA GOSPEL SING. Any group from our supporting churches that would like to sing, please contact me for a slot on the program. This gathering - almost 400 last year - is the largest in the state of West Virginia. Come early to get a seat. The sing will last from 7:00 to 8:30 or 9:00 depending on the number of groups who sign up.

The Family Camp makes no charge except an 85 cent insurance charge for those staying on campus. It is supported solely by free will offerings. PLAN NOW TO EITHER CAMP OUT OR COMMUTE over for each of the main sessions for this area revival. We plead with our supporting churches to TRANSFER (not cancel) their Sunday evening services to the C/A campus for that one evening of the year. Communion will be served for those who did not have an opportunity to partake that morning.
