We ask our supporting churches to **TRANSFER** their Sunday evening service to C/A. Come early because we had near 350 in attendance last year. We will have communion available for those who were not able to attend Sunday morning at their local church.

## COMMENTS ABOUT CAMP!

A week of camp is a life changing experience for not only the campers, but also for all the workers! This season has been no different. As I prepare this Chronicle on the first day of the last week of camp, we have had 383 campers pass through registration, 20 of whom have made decisions publicly at C/A -- 9 by baptism and 11 by rededication! To date, only one camper has been taken to the hospital -- a great record when you have that many people.

We have a summer full of memories with almost a perfect season under our belts. We have experienced no problems to really speak of. Camp has been made possible by "A Family of Workers," literally hundreds of volunteers who either worked directly with your young people or behind the scenes doing such necessary jobs as cleaning buildings, mowing grass, cooking meals, and washing thousands of dishes.

Our over-all attendance for the summer is down only 8 from last year -- we were actually ahead going into our last week by 20 campers, but Senior I was down 28 campers over last year resulting in our net loss. Our Jr. and Jr. High weeks were up, but our Senior weeks lost 40 campers over the previous year. Next year we most likely will combine Senior I and II into just one week due to the fact that we only had 56 total Senior High young people.

As usual we have a couple of cases of clothing left over. We will hold the clothes until the ham supper in September and then dispose of them. We have about a hundred towels, many nice clothes and a lot of Bibles! Initials on your child's clothing would save us hours of work and you hundreds of dollars!

In next month's Chronicle we will give you the complete camp report including our last week that we are in now.
