# C/A ACCOMPLISHMENTS IN PAST TWO YEARS!

October 1 of this year marked my two-year anniversary with the C/A ministry as your Camp Manager and Promotional Director. In those two years, I have been abundantly bless by YOUR efforts for the C/A work. Below a list that I presented to the C/A General Board of what YOU have done in those two years.

- 1. Chronicle published every month since hired on time with good quality and quantity.
- Thousandaire Club has grown from a handful to 162 to date.
- 500 Club started with 56 having participated.
- 4. C.A.R.E., C.A.K.E., and C.A.G.E. programs have resulted in a new and fairly complete recreational equipment center, a revitalization of kitchen equipment and supplies (there were less than 20 forks, knives and spoons when I was hired), including purchase of new kitchen heavy equipment (headed by Don Helmondollar, including purchasing and arranging payment by securing funds personally), and securing many additional other needed items through C.A.G.E.
- 5. New Program started at C/A and elsewheres. Snowball Retreat, First Chance Camp, additional weeks of camp, fellowship meals that have grown from under 200 to almost 400 in number. The Ladies' and Men's Clinic have also received increases.
- 6. New Church support -- added or increased in past two years -- 11 in all.

Hillcrest -- \$10 new Memorial -- \$10 new Cedar Grove -- increased

Pine Grove -- \$100 to \$200

Duhring -- doubled from \$25 to \$50

Pettry -- \$50 to \$60 Ingleside -- \$10 new

Hollybrook -- doubled \$10 to \$20 Lerona -- doubled \$10 to \$20

Lindside -- \$50 new (this month)

- 7. "Pave the Way" project raised money for 35 yds. of concrete for pool. \$2300 project complete and paid for.
- "Chapel/Chair" program raised over \$1600 for chairs -- 250 plus.
- 9. Camp has grown from 250 approx. to 397 in two years.
- Gideon's Program -- 54 have or are participating. Pool paid down from \$36,000 to \$24,000 in one year.
- 11. C/A Slide Program has been presented on a regular basis to most of area churches -- first time in history of C/A.
- 12. Maintenance stepped up -- including Jim repainting all floors and walls, doors painted, buildings washed (not complete), tractor tires purchased.
- 13. Special offerings have increased -- Jesus Birthday - 1981 of \$503.68 to \$1187.06 in 1982: 30 Pieces of Silver from \$2476.41 in 1981 to \$3499.96 in 1982.
- 14. New Septic system installed with inside work 95% complete -- \$3,000 of work complete and paid for.
- 15. Cross Project -- 90% complete, adds beauty to campus.
- 16. Parking Lot constructed -- Phase I near completion. \$490 thus far spent.
- 17. Income doubled in two years. 94% first year, 9.5% this year thus far.
