The General Board in their November meeting designated the money to be used in the general fund as needed. "CADILLAC" MINIATURE GOLF COURSE AVAILABLE!

What we are calling the "cadillac" of miniature golf courses has now become available. It is located in the building next to the old Hills location in Green Valley. Roger Craft offered it to us for \$12,000 but we figure he will take \$10,000 for it. Our only problem is that we have only \$2,321.45 in our savings account to purchase a brand new course. We would like to appeal to an area Christian (or all of you) to make a large contribution for us to be able to purchase this course straight out. Think of the blessing it would be for both campers and church groups to have such a nice course out here at C/A! Please pray about my challenge to YOU! Even a \$5,000 offering would put us close to being able to purchase this new course.

Last month Sunrise Chapel sent \$6 and Bruce and Anita Barilla gave another \$10 to bring us up to the \$2,321.45 mark!

GENERAL BOARD APPROVES GARAGE PROJECT

Our November 15th meeting of the General Board was full of suggestions as to how we could get our new tractor and equipment out of the harsh weather. At another called meeting on Saturday the 23rd, the men saw that we could not add an additional garage on to the existing caretaker's home and then opted to raise money to build a separate building, the size of which will depend on the amount of money raised. THIS WILL BE OUR SPRING PROJECT! For approximately \$7,000 we can put a 28 ft. by 48 building, for \$8,000 a 28 X 60 building. With landscaping and cutting a new road in we can do the entire project for around \$10,000!

We are making an appeal to our supporting churches to get us off on the right foot by sending in \$500 from your general fund, coupled with smaller gifts from area Christians to make up the remainder!
