## C/A ALL New Video Program Debuts In January



#### POOL LEAK LOCATED!

We have located, but not corrected yet, two problems with the pool. We have cut large holes in the pool floor and found a major leak in our return line. We also discovered that the crack in the deep end that has been there for quite a number of years was not a surface crack. This crack is over 30 ft. long and has also allowed over 1500 gallons of water to collect UNDER the pool floor. This also must be repaired! Our loving and special thanks to my good friend, Rick Owens from the Laurel Fork Church of Christ, owner and operator of Southern Gunite, who has loaned us his equipment and men to help in completing this project. We simply couldn't have even started without his companies' help!
