DO YOU STILL WANT TO RECEIVE CHRONICLE?

The Chronicle now cost about .15° a month to print and mail it to you. That doesn't sound like much until you mail out over 2600 copies. If you are receiving duplicate copies or would no longer like to receive the Chronicle you could save C/A about \$1.70 a year by requesting that we drop your family's name from the list. If you attend Duhring, Pine Grove, Montcalm, Midway, Falls Mills, or Mapleview 'I hand deliver their Chronicles. If you attend one of these congregations and would be willing to pick up your Chronicle at church rather than receive it through the mail you could save C/A the mailing fee of 8.5° per month. Just call or drop me a note and I'll pull your plate and add another Chronicle to the list to be given to your congregation. PLEASE HELP US BE GOOD STEWARTS OF THE LORD'S MONEY. And please let us know if you have moved - it cost between 22° and 30° to get your corrected address.

10,000 SOUP LABELS RECEIVED IN 1987!

Approximately 10,000 soup labels were sent to C/A during 1987. Counting what was left over from previous years we now have about 12,000 labels to order some new kitchen equipment. SAVE THOSE LABELS. Remember to cut only the front portion of the labels from the top of the can to bottom of the word CAMPBELLS. PLEASE CUT THEM BEFORE YOU MAIL THEM IN - because it saves you money mailig in just the needed portion of the label - and it saves us hours of time cutting all those labels. Buddy Kitts and I spent several hours just cutting about 2000 labels that had been received uncut. (Many are stil spending Betty Crocker coupons and you may still do that - even though Betty Crocker has discontinued their industrial program. We will still take them because they may renew that program - then we would be ready.)


