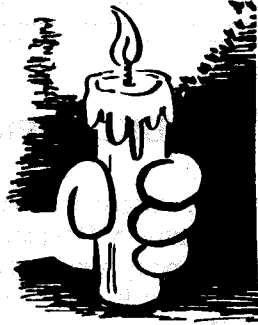

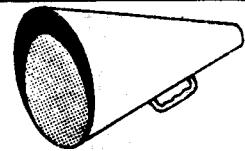
A FEW S.W.A.T. SLOTS LEFT OPEN

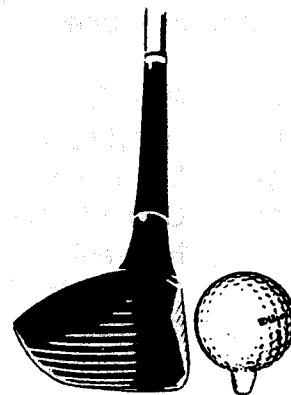
