1996 PROJECT WORK BEGINS

By the time all of you receive this Chronicle, our projects for 1996 will have already begun. On Thursday, Jan. 25th, we plan to start ripping out the old ceilings in the girls' dorms and put in all new steel, tile, lights, and insulation. We will work in one dorm at a time until we have finished all twelve sides. We have also placed an order for 60 new windows to replace the old crank-out style. These will be double insulated, easily removable and cleanable windows. The lowest bid we received on these windows was \$9,000 - - \$140 each for the single and \$190 for the double windows.
