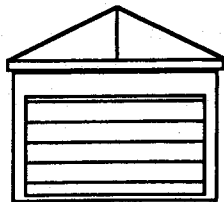

We begin our major spring project this January to start raising \$10,000 to build a new garage at C/A. Last month we appealed to our supporting churches to approach their boards and ask for \$500 to help launch us into this campaign. To date no gifts from anyone have been received but we hope the next 3 months will see a big change as we hit the road personally asking for help! We will need the money by April 1st to begin construction as soon as the weather breaks. Mark your gifts, "Garage," but make your checks always out to Christian Acres.

MINIATURE GOLF COURSE FUND EDGING UPWARD

With an additional \$29 given during December toward the purchase of a miniature golf course -- and now \$2350.45 in the savings account - we are slowly crawling toward the amount needed and at this rate should reach it by 2010! Since our last report we have had another offer of a recently rebuilt course in Parkersburg for around \$5,000 -- including parts of the fence surrounding the course -- we also have to pay to have it moved from Parkersburg in an 18 wheeler semi. We might be able to get the entire course plus moving for around \$5,000 total. This is 1/2 of what we had as our best option to date.

We hope somebody hit the jackpot at Christmas and would like to help us out now! Ha! Seriously, we do need help so we won't lose what is the best buy to date in Parkersburg.
