We begin our major spring project this January to start raising \$10,000 to build a new garage at C/A. Last month we appealed to our supporting churches to approach their boards and ask for \$500 to help launch us into this campaign. To date no gifts from anyone have been received but we hope the next 3 months will see a big change as we hit the road personally asking for help! We will need the money by April 1st to begin contruction as soon as the weather breaks. Mark your gifts, "Garage," but make your checks always out to Christian Acres.

MINIATURE GOLF COURSE FUND EDGING UPWARD

If you would like to help us in 1992 for a specified number of months,


