PAVILLION BASICALLY FINISHED IN 8 DAYS!

What could be said about Nehemiah and his rebuilders of the walls of Jerusalem can now be said about our area men—**THEY HAD A MIND TO WORK!** In just over a week, the forms for the concrete were set, the concrete was poured, the pillars went up, the trusses were placed, and the sheathing and shingles were nailed on. On several days, we had over 15 men present from all over the area to help us do our work. The only day we could have used a little more help was on the Second Saturday of June 9th—otherwise the Lord provided the exact number needed.

Our special thanks to **Tom Brown** who headed up the pavillion project. Our hats off to **Richard Lambert** who donated all our pillars from his lumber mill—and to **all the area men** who spent many hours putting it all together.

The cost thus far on the pavillion had been approximately \$4500. We still want to put electric and water to the facility as soon as possible—and when we get some more money! Our 30 Pieces of Silver offering and Jesus Birthday offering—and 4 groups who promised to give \$100 toward the pavillion collected the \$4500 toward the pavillion as it stands now. It will take several hundred more for completion.
