#### CAMP OFF TO GRAND START

Our second run to the hospital was a hurt wrist that was only bruised but not broken. Our third run was the most frightening when a faculty member passed out in the pool with some type of seizure. Our trained personnel at the pool did an excellent job in handling this situation - so it has been an interesting summer!

We have already had several baptisms and a great deal of "fun in the atmosphere of faith." Our deans have done a good job in organizing and carrying out their plans! We are now looking forward to Handi-camp, Jr. High II with Bob Stanley, Senior I with Danny Starr, and Senior II with Bob Holden, all during July. Danny Starr wanted me to announce that the public is invited to the Friday night closing program at 7:00 on July 22. The young people with be presenting a Youth Musical entitled "Camp Goo-La-Mock-ee!"

#### CAMP FINALLY GETS CABOOSE FOR CANTEEN

The probable location of the new caboose/canteen will be in the upper parking lot in the corner near the lower parking lot pavilion just off the steps coming down from the cafeteria on the lower side. What a treat our young campers will have being able to purchase their drinks and candy from a real caboose! Should be quite a memory!
