CAMP HAS SMOOTH START-UP

No one would have guessed that we had just started! The campus was ready for the influx of 42 Senior II young people on June 16th. We are now in the midst of Junior I as I prepare this Chronicle for press with 80 happy, shouting 4th and 5th graders. This week has been full of surprizes with one of our campers the very first evening slipping on the wet grass and breaking his arm. So from this point of view we have had a shaky start-up with injuries coming at the start of the season rather than in the middle like last year. We had only one all last summer - a broken ankle, which for over 400 young people is a great average. Please pray daily for the rest of the season.
