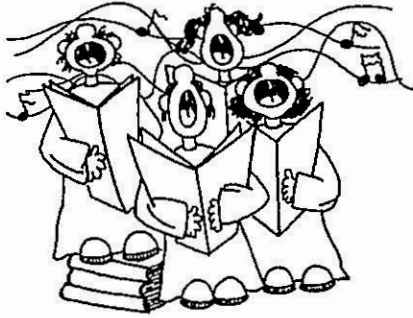
### 4 JOIN T-CLUB!
