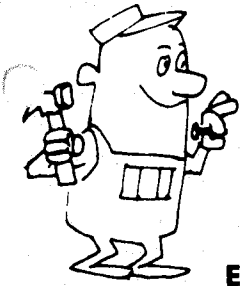

CAMP BEGINS JUNE 19th 450 CAMPERS EXPECTED!
