## CAMP BEGINS JUNE 15th

*It seems like just a few days ago when camp closed out last year with 511 campers - but we are gearing up for 540 this year. Below are just a few instructions we will like to emphasize for this year's program.*

- 1. Get your registration card in as soon as possible. We will accept only 100 campers for each week of camp. Registration is always in the C/A Cafeteria.**
- 2. All weeks will end on Friday night at 8:30, except First Chance camp which ends on Tuesday night at 8:30, and Handicap camp which ends Friday night after supper about 6:30. (The Closing Program will begin about 7:00 for most weeks).**
- 3. Junior Counselors and SWAT must fill out a camp registration card for medical information only.**
- 4. Be sure to mark each campers clothing, especially undergarments, towels, washcloths, swimming clothes, with an indelible pen.**
- 5. Pray for Jim and I, all camp staff and workers, and the campers especially that the Lord will bless us with a happy, healthy, prosperous summer for HIM!**
