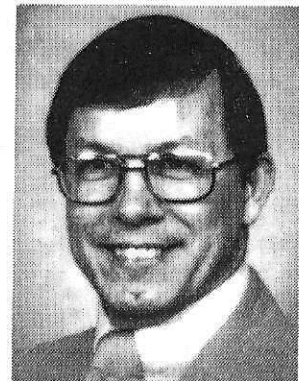

CAMP BEGINS JUNE 14TH!

Soon the campus at C/A will be filled with the boisterous laughter of young people enjoying C/A camp-fun in the the atmosphere of camp. In the past six years alone, the ministry has had 203 baptisms, 289 rededications, and 14 life recruits! Pray for another season of harvested souls! Pray daily for the staff and the students - that while they are here, all will be protected from harm. Our goal is always to have a safe summer with NO runs to the area hospital. Below are a few details we want you all to be aware of:

1. A WORD ABOUT THE CAMP CARD - First, there is a mistake on the backside of the camp registration card - the fee is \$35 instead of \$30 - with a \$5.00 discount off the \$35 fee, making a full week for \$30. A half week cost only \$17.50 instead of \$15, but you can save \$2.50 if you pre-register at least two weeks in advance. Our printer ran an old card with the old fee.
2. A WORD ABOUT PRE-REGISTERING - you can register ANYTIME , including the day that camp starts if we have room - but the **pre-registration deadline** will save you \$5.00 if you get your card in before that time.
3. A WORD ABOUT CANTEEN - For the first two junior weeks and for First Chance, we sell each camper a CANTEEN CARD - so these little ones will not loose their money. ANY MONEY LEFT ON THE CARD CAN BE CLAIMED AT THE END OF CAMP. Money not claimed on that day will be automatically transferred into the missions fund for that week of camp.
4. A WORD ABOUT CLOTHING - please don't send your camper to camp with SHORT SHORTS or immodest bathing suits, AND PLEASE mark their clothing with indelible ink so we will be able to return lost towels and undergarments to them at the close of camp. We know that parents often pack the suitcases of younger children and they honestly don't know what belongs to them or someone else. At least put their initials on towels, bathing suits, and undergarments. These are the most frequent items left after camp has ended.
5. A WORD ABOUT MONEY - We NEVER turn any camper down regardless of whether he can pay or not. We have many are Christians who are willing to help. Don't let your child miss coming to C/A Summer Camp just because of money. We will take a loss rather than not have a child at camp.
