CAMP BEGINS JUNE 12TH

Another "Mountaintop Experience" awaits hundreds of campers here at Christian Acres, as camp begins on June 12th. Our goal is to have 500 campers this summer - and not have one run to the hospital! During the month of June we will have Junior I week of camp being directed by Bruce Graff; Junior II, being helmed by Mr. Simon Says himself, Rick Burdette, and Jr. High I being harpooned by "Moby" Dick Brown. Special Note To All Area Christians: On Wednesday night, June 29th, 40 young people from Raleigh, NC will be presenting a Christian musical for the camp and for the public. We will be mailing out posters to give you additional information for this grand event.

Below are a few important reminders:

1. Assure your camper a slot by sending in your registration card by the pre-registration deadline and save yourself \$5 in the process. We accept only the first 100 campers to register for each week of camp.
2. Be sure to mark each camper's clothing with indelible ink. Mark undergarments, towels, washcloths, and swimming clothes especially.
3. All weeks end on Friday night about 8:30, except for First Chance which ends on Tuesday night at 8:30 and Handicap week which ends on Friday night about 6:30. The closing program starts about 7:00 for most weeks if you would like to attend.
4. Junior Counselors and SWAT must fill out a camp registration card for medical information only. There is no fee.
5. We turn down no camper because of the lack of money. However, we do need Camp Scholarship sponsors to help us with this cost. You only need to send in \$30 to help pay for a child who cannot afford to come.
6. Please pray for Jim and I, all camp staff and workers, and the campers especially that the Lord will bless us all with another happy and healthy camp season!

Churches who book the pool are also charged 50 cents per person plus \$10 to pay the lifeguard for her two hours of service.
