CAMP BEGINS JUNE 14

Our annual camp season will be kicked off with Handicamp June 14-15, followed by Junior I with Bruce Graff for 4th-5th graders and then Junior II with Ken Overdorf June 25-30 for 5th and 6th graders. Let your child experience, "Fun in the atmosphere of faith," by encouraging them to take advantage of the greatest week of their life here on the C/A campus. With our new caboose canteen and basketball court, plus all the other already built-in features of the C/A campus and program, your child is guaranteed to come home a different individual.

Below are a few reminders:

1. Assure your camper a slot by sending in your registration card by the pre-registration deadline and save yourself \$5 in the process. We accept only the first 100 campers.
2. BE SURE TO USE PERMANENT INK TO INITIAL YOUR CHILD'S CLOTHING. Mark undergarments towels, washcloths, and swimming clothes especially.
3. NOTE NEW RULES - ABSOLUTELY NO TAPEDECKS, BOOM BOXES, RADIOS ETC. EVEN FOR CHRISTIAN MUSIC -(SEE REGISTION CARD - RULE 10.) Also note rule 5 about French style cut women's bathing suits - they are not permitted.
4. All full weeks of camp end on Friday night at 8:00 to 8:30. We would like to encourage all parents not to pick up their kids earlier -but be a part of the closing program which starts at 7:00.
5. Junior Counselors and SWAT must fill out one registration card for the summer for medical reasons. There is no fee.
6. We turn down no camper because they have no money. However, we do need CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS to help us with the cost. If your group is interested, please contact Rick at the camp.
7. Last but not least--mention the camp, the counselors, and the campers in your prayers each day!
