CAMP STARTS JUNE 17

Another C/A "Mountaintop Experience" begins for area youth and adults as we kick off another camp season at Christian Acres. Let your young person experience "fun in the atmosphere of faith" as he climbs the mountain to get a new look at God and himself. This week will change his life but only if you encourage your child to come! Below are a few reminders about the 1990 season:

- 1. Assure your campers a slot in the program by sending in your registration card and \$5.00 fee early. We accept only the first 100 campers. You save yourself \$5.00 by registering early.
- 2. BE SURE TO USE PERMANENT INK TO INITIAL YOUR CHILD'S CLOTHING....Mark undergarments, towels, washcloths, and swimming clothes especially. These are the most common items left.
- 3. All full weeks of camp end on Friday between 8:00 and 8:30. Since your child is an important part of the closing program, please don't take them home early -- and try your best to be a part of that closing program at 7:00.
- 4. Junior Couselors and SWAT must fill out ONE card for medical emergencies. There is no fee.
- We turn down no camper because of a lack of money. However, we do need CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS to help us with the cost.
- 6. LAST BUT NOT LEAST -- PRAY DAILY FOR THE CAMP, THE COUNSELORS, AND THE CAMPERS!
