GENERAL BOARD NEWS

Our quarterly meeting of the C/A General Board was held February 16th at Mapleview. Several important decisions were made to determine the future of the camp.

- 1. ELECTION OF OFFICERS FOR 1990: Jonce Leedy was selected Chairman; Bruce Barilla was nominated Vice-Chariman; Jimmy Belcher was chosen as Secretary; Don Helmondollar is still Treasurer, having served since day one in that position. Selected to serve on the Executive Committee with these officers and Jim and Rick were Buddy Kitts, Dick Brown, and Clarence Bowman.
- 2. USE OF THE B-A-M ACCOUNT: Originally set up for projects only, the Board extended the use to cover short-falls in the general fund. Money will be used on emergency basis only to help to meet current expenses.
- 3. CAMP TO PURCHASE NEW TRACTOR: Our old tractor is 19 years old and needs some repair, so the Board decided to purchase a new Russian built 4 wheel drive tractor, most likely from a dealer in Tazewell for approximately \$10,000. Money from the escrow account will be used to make the down payment. The rest will be borrowed. When we sell the old tractor and sickle bar, this money will be immediately applied to this loan. IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO HELP IN PAYING OFF THIS LOAN AS SOON AS POSSIBLE, PLEASE MARK YOUR CHECKS TRACTOR FUND." If you are interested in the old tractor, contact me at the office number of 589-6296. We would like to get \$3500 for this tractor.
