GENERAL BOARD ELECTS NEW CHAIRMAN RAISES CAMP TUITION

At the Feb. 15th meeting of the General Board, Jonce Leedy, chairman for the last ten years, stepped down. During his term, over \$150,000 worth of improvements were made to the campus. We owe a great deal to him for his leadership. The board then elected Dick Brown, Peterstown minister as the new Chairman for 1991. Bruce Barilla is Vice-Chairman, Don Helmondollar, Treasurer, and Jimmy Belcher, Secretary. Clarence Bowman, Gene Leedy, and Mike Lynn were nominated from the floor to fill up the posts for the Executive Committee.

The 21 men present also voted to raise camp tuition for 1991 by \$5 for a full week. The cost now will be \$45 if not pre-registered and \$40, if pre-registered at least two weeks in advance. This still is far below most of our camps and way below secular camps!
