WATER LEAK FOUND AND REPAIRED

Instead of leaking about 1000 gallons of water in a 24 hour period. We were actually losing about 4000 gallons in the same time period due to TWO major water leaks. First, the check value at the well was bad, allowing water to go straight back down the well as soon as the pump turned off. The second major water leak was UNDER THE WALK about half way between the cafeteria and administration building. Repairs have now been made for about \$450.00! A special thanks to Homer Moore from Midway who located the leak for us!
