#### JIM HALE CONTRACT AND NEWS

We didn't have room last month to report to our supporting churches the new contract for Jim covering April 1 to December 31 of this year worked out in detail by the Executive Committee. Jim will be paid \$185 per week, \$50 per month truck allowance, and \$230 for insurance per month for this time period, with the stipulation that if Jim is off work due to sickness, he will not be paid his salary, insurance, or truck allowance for each week missed.

Jim had another bout with his leg and spent from April 18 until April 26th in the hospital. As of the date I am typing this Chronicle, the 26th, Jim is home recuperating and is doing well. Jim has informed both the General Board and Executive Committee that he will retire December 31st or sooner, depending on his health. By December Jim will have 25 years of service in to C/A!
