CAMP OR NO CAMP -- DECISION TO BE MADE BY MAY 25TH

Via a conference call of the Executive Committee on April 21st, the men have set a date of May 25th to let our churches know about the summer camping program. As many of you are aware with the Covid-19 virus, our whole world is a different world since March. Church buildings have been closed, businesses shut down, and activities curtailed with social distancing and stay-at-home orders in place on a national scale. C/A already cancelled the Ladies Day, Men's Clinic, the ACC convention, as well as board meetings, etc. for both April and May. Now we must make the hardest decision of all, should we have camp or not during June and July? Even though restrictions are being lifted possibly in early May, social distancing, etc. will still be in play for the foreseeable future! We don't know how we could operate dorms, the pool, playground activities, etc. and maintain the CDC guidelines. Our board has decided to have two more conference calls May 7th and May 21st at which time we will have a clearer picture of the effects on trying to get back to a half - normal lifestyle. As stated above, we will let everyone know what we can and will be able to offer this summer, if anything, by May 25th. For right now everything is on hold; we are not purchasing any more food supplies, etc. in preparation for camp until after that date. We have been in contact with other camps, many of whom have already cancelled for the summer, and others like us who are waiting to see what May brings so we can make an informed decision.

We would appreciate any comments that you may have via email or by phone before May 25th as to what you think we could and should do. We are most concerned that if we have a Covid-19 case on campus it will quarantine our cooks, lifeguards, campers, deans and their staff and thus would shout down camp anyhow for the remainder of the summer. Understand that we have campers from multiple states, counties, etc. that would form a dangerous mix ripe for the virus to strike on campus. We are also concerned that parents will not send their kids or even allow their teens to work in camp. It also thwarts our efforts to have adult workers, some who are already vulnerable due to pre-existing conditions, being able to work as well. Other concerns we have are how we would be able to sanitize the whole campus, perhaps multiple times per day when these supplies are not able to be purchased. With restrictions on food purchases being limited we are not even sure we can secure the supplies necessary to run our camping program. With our churches facing financial woes because they haven't been able to meet and with the cancellation of their VBS program in June already, some have informed us that they won't be able to pay for their campers to come to camp. While we have been greatly blessed, our income suffered a \$6,000.00 shortfall for the month of April alone compared to last year. This is due in part to the fact that we have been and will still be unable to present the video programs in our local churches to help raise money for camp.

In spite of the fear we all are experiencing, our hope and trust lies in the Lord. Please pray along with us that HIS will be done, and that He will guide us in making the right decision.
