THE DECADE OF THE 80'S Highlighting Some Improvements

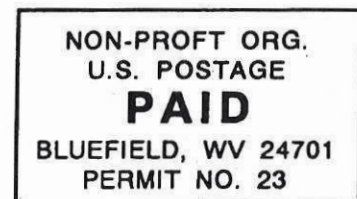
