



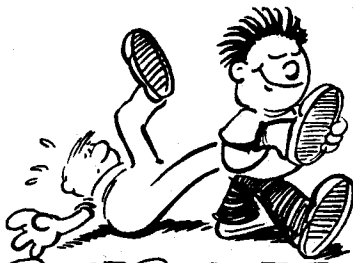

We repaired 137 broken black runner tiles in the bottom of the pool, fixed the crack in between the two decks (the crack repair took about 25 man hours alone), cut out the new entrances and have the walls up. We now have to put the new doors in, paint all the interior and put up a privacy stall in the women's side, and then we well be done. From here we hope to move on in mid-October to the chapel and repair the ceiling in this building by installing a lowered ceiling and new lights. These projects will cost around \$5,000 for both!
