

UPDATE ON GYM PROJECT

Our Executive Committee held two meetings in September to work on the gym designs, etc. The first bid was way beyond what we had expected but at least gave us a reference point as to what we can afford. We will now be seeking more bids that hopefully will be within our budget. Right now our gym fund stands at \$526,704.72 as of August 31st. If these bids come in way over what we hope, then we may erect the structure and then add all the interior work as money becomes available. Of course all the work that we are able to do ourselves will help cut down the cost. We will keep everyone updated and hold meetings with all our supporting churches once those bids come in as to what we hope to do.

TRAILER AND LOWER PAVILION TO GET NEW GUTTERING

We have a bid submitted now for both the trailer guttering as well as new guttering for the lower pavilion for \$2,150.00. The new guttering on the lower pavilion includes new face board on the front where rain constantly creates a dangerous, slick entrance for those using that facility. It also includes replacing the leaking guttering on the backside. This work will hopefully be done in the next 5 weeks and completed before the snow begins to fly!
