RICK AVAILABLE FOR REVIVALS, SEMINARS, ETC.

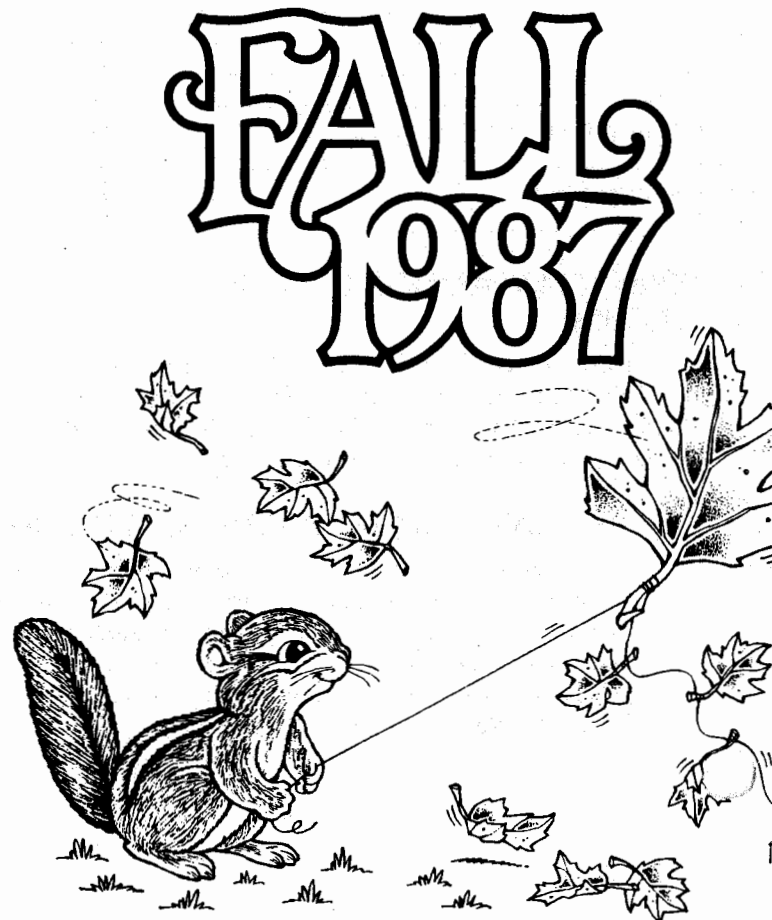
