360 ATTEND GOSPEL RALLY AT FAMILY CAMP

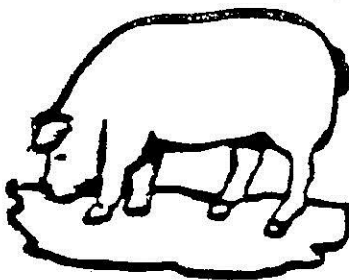

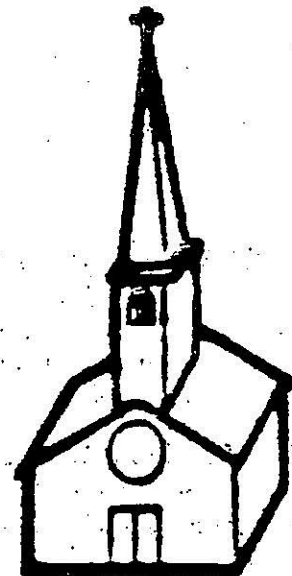
PREACHER'S MEETING IS SEPT. 18TH
