## NEWEST PROJECT: MINIATURE GOLF COURSE

### COMDISCO SENDS \$1000 GIFT FOR MINIATURE GOLF

On August 12th, we received the following note from Comdisco, an Illinois based company: "Enclosed please find Comdisco's check in the amount of \$1000 to help fund a miniature golf course for your area church camp...Comdisco is pleased to help support this organization and the individuals that it serves. Best of luck in achieving your future goals."

This is the second \$1000 gift from the Chicago area raised by Bruce and Joe Barilla and with the General Board's permission opens the drive for our newest project here at C/A — a complete 18 hole miniature golf course. See the article below for more information.

### MINIATURE GOLF COURSE APPROVED BY GENERAL BOARD

With \$2,000 already in the bank (plus \$187.45 from the Gospel Sing), the General Board gave approval at their August 16th meeting to go ahead with the project of purchasing (or building one ourself) a miniature golf course hopefully to be installed by the 1991 camp season.

Currently we are in contact with 3 area businesses that may be interested in selling their miniature golf course. The best price we have is \$5,000 — but we hope to make a counter offer for less than that amount hoping this man will accept our offer.

The course will be set up on the level just below the pool and will be available to local churches, campers, and about any C/A member on the campus. It is planned to be in operation free of charge (unless we have a lot of damage done) from May until September and then will be placed in storage during the winter months.
