In 1994 we had only 399 campers -- so I think you all can see just how much we were up in all categories this summer.

We experienced only 3 problems the whole camp season and these have been reported to the General Board and Executive Committee. By reviewing these problems, we can insure they won't happen again and improve an already great camp.
