LADIES PRAYER RETREAT OCT. 1-2!

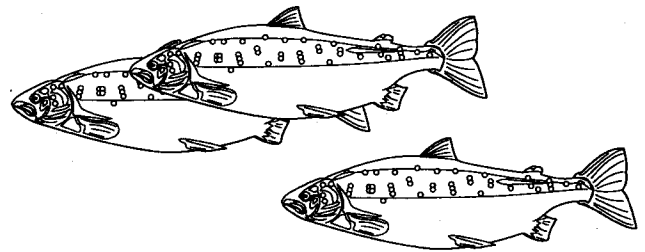
