JAMBOREE FOR CHRIST SET FOR SEPT. 30TH

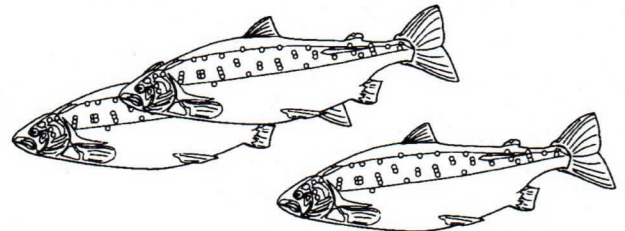
