


GOSPEL SING A BIG HIT!

For the second year in a row, the C/A pool had to be closed due to the growth of algae. Officials in Roanoke say it is the acid rain. After spending about \$200 on chemicals to try to remedy the situation, we shut it down. Apparently the only way to stop the growth is to empty the pool (2-3 days of pumping) and fill it back up with fresh water (21 days of pumping 8 hours per day).
