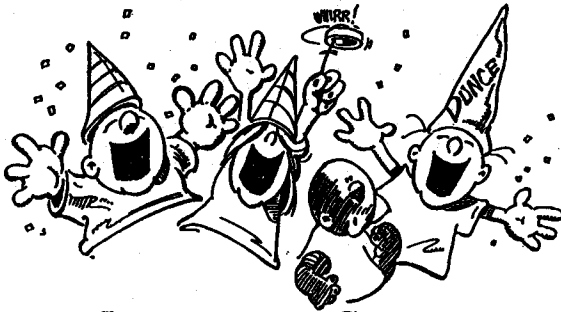

## JAMBOREE FOR CHRIST IS SEPTEMBER 20TH!

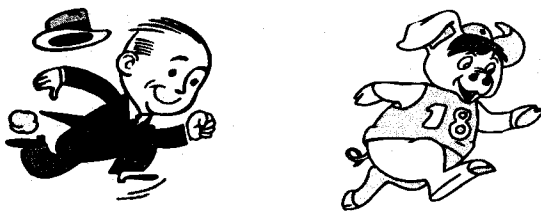
