Saturday begins with Family Devotions at 9:00 a.m., with workshops following from 9:25 till 11:05. The Saturday morning main session begins at 11:15. Saturday afternoon we have family recreation with the hayride at 4:00, followed by the HOT-DOG roast at 5:00. We'll have a pre-concert session beginning at 6:30 that night.
