The last weekend in August, the 25-27th, C/A will host its annual C/A FAMILY CAMP AND REVIVAL SERVICES. Friday night at 7:00, Saturday morning at 11:15 a.m., and again Saturday night at 7:00 Ed Bousman will speak on the theme, "BACK TO THE BASICS." Ed is a premiere preacher in our brotherhood, nationally known and respected. Through both his radio and TV ministry broadcast across most of the nation, Ed echoes the messages of N.T. Christianity almost every day of the week. You will miss a treat if you miss Ed Bousman!

In addition to this grand preaching, we will have workshops again highlighting our theme "Back to the Basics.. Evangelism... The Cross,..The Devil,..The Resurrection,..The Second Coming, and The Christian Family." These workshops will be held Saturday morning.
