GENERAL INCOME UP DUE TO SPECIAL GIFT

For the first nine months of this year - from January - October our gift income has been \$66,068.74 compared to \$65,558.76 last year for the same time period. However, not counting the \$5,000 one time gift we received several months back our income would be down by about \$500 per month. Several of our area congregations have had to cut back on their missions giving to the camp due to their own financial problems. Maybe your congregation could help pick up the slack for 1989!
