# ARE YOU WILLING TO BE CHALLENGED?

Have you noticed how much the cost of living has increased lately? The price of everything is increasing. Some people may be wondering how we can continue to evangelize the lost, how we can continue the Christian Service Camp and Children's Home with the prices of everything so hige.

It looks as if the Lord has given us a job that we simply can't afford to complete. A little mathematical figuring, however, can erase any doubts that we may have about our ability to pay the cost of doing God's work.

We now have approximately 2500 names on our mailing list here at Christian Acres. If we could sufficiently challenge just 1/5 of that number; that is, 500, to sacrifice 20¢ a day to Christian Acres (over and above their regular contributions) it would amaze you what we could do. That 20¢ is the cost of a cup of coffee or a candy bar—not much when you come down to it. This means that 500 Christians would be giving an extra 20¢ a day or \$73.00 a year. Now that's not much is it? However, multiply that by 500 and you come up with \$36,500 per year over and above what we now receive.

We could use that to pay off the notes remaining on Christian Acres. Or, we could send 500 children to Christian Service Camp at \$20 each, (\$10,000). We could build a garage/storage room for the Children's Home, (\$3,000). We could build a volley ball court, basketball court for the camp, (\$5,000). We could put in a swimming pool, (\$18,500). All of this would be just for one year—think what we could do the next year!

If we could challenge 500 people to do this, we could eliminate the Thousandair Club, we wouldn't have to ask the Churches to contribute \$25 toward the cost of camp or toward the cost of our rallies and clinics.

Just think, all of this if we could just challenge 500 Christians to give  $20\phi$  a day. Will you consider this challenge? If your answer is, "Yes!" tear off the portion on the back of this newsletter for just this purpose. Be sure your address is correct and check the "Yes" box. We'll be counting on your  $20\phi$  to help us to great things for God here at the Camp and Children's Home.
