CHRONICLE EXPENSE REVIEW:

We can give you a few statistics now to show each one of you how much the Chronicle has climbed in the past few months. In November, to print and mail the Chronicle cost \$275. In December the price tag was \$449 - before the P.O. raised the cost from .6° to 7.4° each. In January the cost was about \$450 with printing cost going down and mailing costs going up. It now costs C/A .16° a month to mail each of you this Chronicle. While we have recieved notification from some of you that you still want to receive the Chronicle, we still need to hear from others of you who may want to have your name removed because you are no longer associated with the ministry here. We have removed approximately 200 names bringing down the total mail out to just over 2600.

We want to thank the folks listed below who sent in \$162 this past month to help out with the increased expense. We also got some touching notes from even some of our campers who enjoyed reading the Chronicle. These short notes really en-

couraged us!
