Overview of Individual Giving Methods at C/A!

A.C.T. - This is the program started in 2010 for Additional Camp Tuition to keep us from raising tuition. We ask for \$15.00 for each camper you would like to underwrite the actual cost of camp.

SCHOLARSHIP- We have a number of children each summer who cannot afford the initial cost of camp tuition, canteen and sometimes even clothes. This fund sets aside money to help with these expenses.

BAM - Buck-A-Month members give \$1.00 each month (or \$12.00 a year) either through their local church, sunday school, or video program. THOUSANDAIRE CLUB — these individuals give \$10.00 in May and November of each year. KEY CLUB — these are monthly contributors ranging from \$5.00 up to \$100.00 monthly, although no cap has been set upon how much a person can contribute.

PROJECTS — during our video presentations and through the pages of the Chronicle we appeal for help to do our yearly projects. We also receive periodic gifts for the pool fund.

MEMORIAL GIFTS — each year we receive approximately 25 gifts from individuals wishing to remember their loved ones or friends.

SPECIAL OFFERINGS — we ask individuals to contribute to the Jesus Birthday offering in December and to the 30 Pieces of Silver offering in the Spring.

As I prepare this Chronicle for press on Jan. 24th, we have to date received \$6,387.00 from 35 churches and individuals. A special thanks to everyone who helped out—see a complete listing in this month's financial report!
