CAMP BEGINS JUNE 16th

It seems like just a few days ago when camp closed out last year with 501 campers - but we are gearing up for 540 this year. Below are just a few instructions we will like to emphasize for this year's program.

- Get your registration card in as soon as possible. We will accept only 100 campers for each week of camp.
- 2. All weeks, except First Chance camp, which ends on Tuesday night at 8:30, will end FRIDAY night at 8:30. (Closing program is normally about 7:00 if you wish to view this.)
- Junior Counselors and SWAT must fill out a camp registration card for medical information only.
- 4. Be sure to mark each campers clothing, especially undergarments, towels, washcloths, swimming clothes, with an indelible pen.
- 5. Pray for Jim and I, all camp staff and workers, and the campers especially that the Lord will bless us with a happy, healthy, prosperous summer for HIM!

MEN'S CLINIC JUST A FEW DAYS AWAY!

Gary Serago will be with us on June 14-15 for the men's big event - THE ANNUAL C/A MEN'S CLINIC, beginning with the supper meal at 6:00. Registration will begin at 5:00. Tom Long, Chairman, has a great

program of preaching and special music lined up with the Goins Brothers highlighting the music. You men mark your calendars - and plan to stay for the ENTIRE clinic which will end on Saturday after lunch.

C/A - BUCK - A - MONTH CLUB

At the General Board Meeting on May 17th, those men present unanimously approved the beginning of the BUCK-A-MONTH program to start immediately in the area churches and among individual supporters of C/A. The program is really simple. We will be mailing each church enough BUCK-A-MONTH sheets to hand out in each adult Sunday School class. We would like to encourage each adult to give, as God prospers, through their class or through the church, just \$1 each month. After collecting this offering one time a month, the money is turned over to the church treasurer, who in turn writes C/A a check for that amount. We do want a listing of the names of the BUCK-A-MONTH members though so we can list this in the Chronicle. Midway has already issued a challenge for 100% participation to all area supporting churches - and they already have 38 members signed up just on one Sunday night. Our goal is have 1000 people giving \$1 by Sept. 1 and 2,000 people participating within a year on a regular monthly basis. This money will go directly toward projects at C/A that will improve the campus for campers and adults. Some of the first we receive will be used to build the outdoor teaching centers and also provide playground equipment for the pavillion area.

30 PIECES OF SILVER OFFERING IS \$2,051.02

This month's financial report is only what was sent in for the 30 Pieces of Silver offering before April 23. The grand total for this year was \$2,051.02. Don will list the others in next month's report. 13 churches and 10 individuals in all contributed to bring our offering to within \$125 of what it was last year. (Coupled with the Jesus Birthday offering, the two offerings totaled \$5,022.24 - the largest since I have been camp manager.) Thanks everyone for helping in such a grand way! The money is already being invested in the projects to ready us for camp.
