



APPLICATIONS FOR NEW CARETAKER BEING ACCEPTED

Starting as early as April 1st, C/A needs a new caretaker. To give all of our churches an equal chance at having one of their men fill this 6 month part or full-time job, we are hereby giving any male member of our supporting churches a chance to send in a resume and application to the camp no later than March 31st. The Executive Committee will review these applications the first Thursday of April and notify you if they decide to hire you.

The caretaker will have a job description but primarily will work as a janitor, cleaning buildings, a grounds man taking care of the grass and trim work, and pool man, with some maintenance work. Salary will most likely start at \$5.00 per hour with consideration given for more experience. Depending on the person who, for example, would be in college now and could only work part-time until they got out of school in May, we would hire them 20 hours a week from April until Mid-May, put them on full-time until they returned to college in August, and then have them work 20 hours until Oct. 31st.
