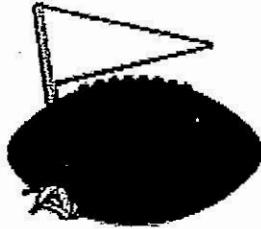

A.E.P. WON'T COVER DAMAGES

We got the definitive word that AEP will not pay for the damages that their transformer caused both at the pool and at the well on June 26th. We will be filing a complaint with the WV Consumer's Commission and possibly with the Attorney General of WV but these will not aid in recouping our loss.
